







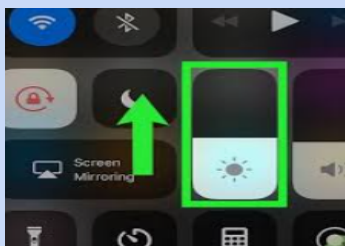
iPad Accessibility Features

The following tiered chart contains examples of resources/supports that can be utilized with all students to meet individual needs.

Tier 1 - CORE Accessible Technology that benefits MOST students.	Tier 2 - INTERVENTION Assistive Technology that benefits SOME students with additional learning requirements.	Tier 3 - INTENSIVE INTERVENTION Assistive Technology that benefits SPECIFIC students with individualized learning requirements.

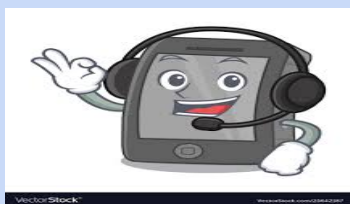

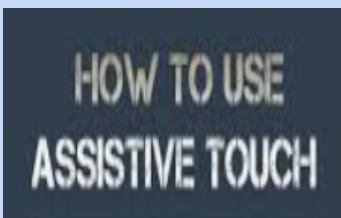

Navigate the iPad by touching a switch



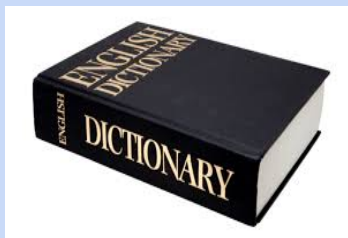

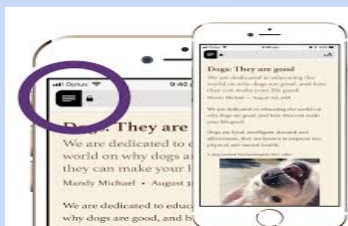
