Scholarship Criteria:

- Must be in good academic standing, maintaining an average of a B- or above.
- Demonstration of citizenship through acts that have positively impacted a population.
- Must be a graduating senior and funds must be used for post-secondary education.
- Must have attended FHS for a minimum of two years.
- Financial need is NOT necessary to apply for this scholarship.
