

## FAQs

Framingham Public Schools is launching a **FREE** Summer Park Meetup program over the summer. Managed by our Department of Community Resource Development, Families are invited to join us at the various parks and times below to join us for yard games and activities. Registration is NOT required!

**Q: Are meetups weather dependent? Will the park meetup be postponed in case it rains?**

**A:** The Park Meet Up will depend on the weather. Meets will not be postponed or rescheduled to a later date. To keep up with all of the latest updates and information, communication will go out via REMIND and Facebook, <https://www.facebook.com/framinghamcrrd>

**Q: Can I drop off my child/ren and leave?**

**A:** No. All children must be accompanied by an adult or guardian. We encourage parents/guardians to participate with their child/ren.

**Q: Can we only attend the locations near our child/ren school?**

**A:** All locations are open for all FPS families. You can attend any Park Meet UP across the district.

**Q: Will there be bilingual staff?**

**A:** Yes! We will have staff that speak English, Spanish, and Portuguese. All activities will be explained in English. Bilingual Staff will be there to assist.

**Q: Is there an age limit? What ages are these activities appropriate for?**

**A:** Activities are designed for children ages 3 and up.

**Q: Will food/drinks be provided? Can I bring food/drink with me?**

**A:** Water will be provided. You are welcome to bring your own food and snacks.

**Q: Do I have to stay the whole time? Do I have to sign a permission slip?**

**A:** Feel free to come and go as you please. You are not required to stay the entire time.

**Q: May I bring my children's friends?**

**A:** Yes. However, you will be responsible to supervise them throughout the activities.

**Q: How does it work for allergies/epi pens? What happens if my child gets hurt?**

**A:** Each family is responsible for bringing any medications needed for their child/ren. We will have first aid kits available.
