Role of Research and Advocacy Associate:

To anchor, coordinate and support youth-centric projects at the Kanaja Research and Advocacy Centre, with a focus on research design, tool development, and documentation, while actively contributing to advocacy efforts through campaigns, outreach, and dissemination of Kanaja's research and publications.

Key Responsibilities:

- Support the design and implementation of research projects, especially those focused on youth and social justice issues
- Identify research tools such as surveys, interview guides, and discussion frameworks for research projects
- Conduct fieldwork (include facilitating workshops), data collection through interviews, focus group discussions, and surveys
- Transcribe, translate, and organize qualitative and quantitative data
- Assist in data analysis and contribute to research reports, publications, and presentations
- Support the dissemination of research findings through events, publications, and digital platforms
- Support the planning and implementation of advocacy campaigns related to relevant youth focussed research projects
- Build and maintain relationships with stakeholders, including youth groups, community organizations, networks, and policymakers
- Assist in organizing advocacy events, consultations, and meetings at local, regional, and national levels
