GAME DURATION	All matches shall consist of 2 x 12 minute halves with a 2 minute interval at half time.
TEAM	A maximum of twelve (12) players may be used in one game. Seven (7) players on the court and up to five (5) interchange players are to be named for each game.
POINTS AWARDED	4 points for a WIN 2 points for a DRAW 0 points for a LOSS If, at the end of the round robin, two teams are equal on points, then the winner of the face to face match will be declared the winner. If their face to face match was a draw, then the total percentage from all their games will be used to determine the winner. If more than two teams are tied on points, percentage from the matches involving the other tied teams will be calculated to determine the winner.

The level of competition chosen by a student at District level remains binding through to Division, Region and State levels.

EQUIPMENT	Players must wear same colour skirts/bodysuits/shorts (without pockets) and same colour tops with contrasting bibs. Fingernails should be taped or cut and no visible jewellery can be worn.
FIRST AID	Competing schools are responsible for ensuring that reasonable provision is made for the treatment of injuries. All schools participating in SSV Team Sports are required to bring their own first aid kit.
SCHOOL AREA	On arrivals all schools are to identify a seating area in the stadium where they can set up their bags.
UMPIRES	Umpires will be assigned a court throughout the day having two umpires per court.
SCORER	Each school must supply a scorer. Please ensure this is a parent or teacher and not a child. Score sheets will be provided.
SPECTATORS	Spectators are to watch from an area that is off the courts.
