Abstract

Written in italics in English containing key issues, research objectives, methods/approaches, and research results. The abstract is written in one paragraph, no less than 150 words and no more than 250 words. (Using Garamond size 12, 1.0 spacing)

Keywords: *Minimum 2 words, Maximum 5 keywords, each word separated by commas. (Using Garamond size 12, 1.0 spacing, written in italics)*

Introduction (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

Explain the background of your article concisely and in detail using scientific arguments and supported by adequate data. In this section, also discuss the research problem and your research hypothesis. Include in this section a literature review (state of the art) of the research to demonstrate that the article you are writing has elements of novelty and is important to be written. The introduction section ends with outlining the purpose of writing the article.

The introduction contains the background, rationale, and detailed explanation using scientific arguments and supported by adequate data based on the urgency of the research, as well as presenting a problem clearly and concisely as the basis for conducting the research that will be written as a scientific article. In the introduction, only the literature that is truly important and relevant to the problem is referenced to serve as a basis and theoretical foundation for the research, or to support the

hypothesis. The introduction must also explain the concrete reasons for the selection and importance of the research activities, and conclude by stating the objectives of the research implementation. (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

Research Methodology (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

The research implementation flow must be written in detail and clearly so that other researchers can conduct the same research. (repeatable and reproduceable). Explain your methodology and how you solve the research problem. Type of research, time and place of research, targets/objectives, research subjects, procedures, data and instruments, data collection techniques, data analysis techniques. (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

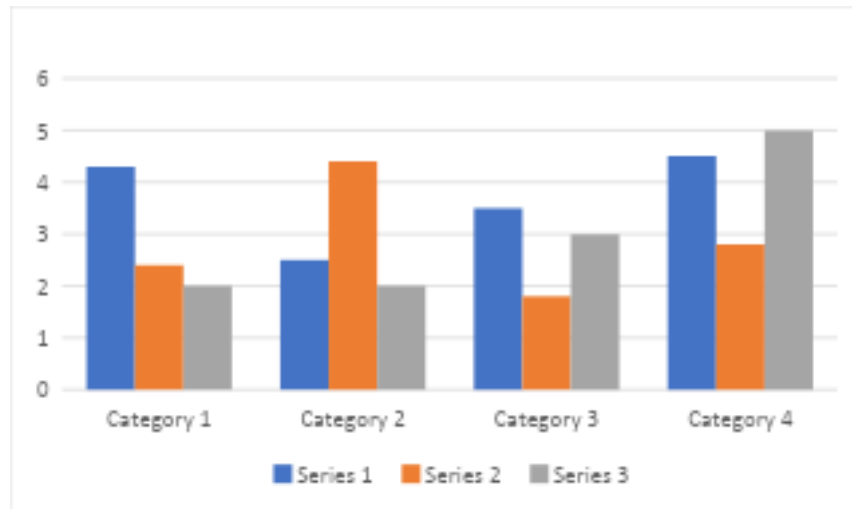
Results and Discussion (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

Explain your research findings in accordance with the research problem and objectives. Discuss your findings in accordance with theories, hypotheses, concepts, and/or previous findings. Explain this section comprehensively, simply, and in detail. The research results in the form of data are presented to inform the findings of the research that has been conducted. Illustrations of research results can use graphs/tables/images. Tables and graphs must be understandable and adequately labeled. The results presented are only significant findings that are relevant to the research objectives. The Table Title is written at the top, centered from the left, with all words capitalized except for conjunctions. If it has more than one line, it should be written in single spacing. For example, see Table 1 below:

Results in the form of images, or data represented as images/schemes/graphs/diagrams/similar, should also follow the existing rules; the title or name of the image is placed below the image, from the left, with a 1-space gap from the image. If there are more than 1 line, single spacing is applied between the lines. For example, it can be seen in Figure 1. Below.

Unexpected findings that do not align with the research objectives must be given a place for discussion. If the article reports more than one experiment, the objectives of each study must be clearly stated in the text, and the results must be linked to each other. In the Discussion, the relationship between research results and theory is presented, along with a comparison of the research results with those of other published studies. The discussion also explains the implications of the findings for science and their applications. (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

Conclusion (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

The conclusion is the author's affirmation regarding the research results and discussion, outlining key points that illustrate the answers to the research questions. Suggestions should be based on the research findings, have practical implications, contribute to the development of new theories (especially for doctoral programs), and/or lead to further research. Suggestions can serve as input for the next researcher, or they can be implicit recommendations derived from the research findings. (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

References (Garamond size 12, 1.15 spacing)

The references cited in the writing of articles in the Journal of Islamic Guidance and Counseling must come from primary sources (scientific journal articles) published in the last 10 years, at least 80%. The minimum number of references is 25, and at least 3 sources must be cited from articles in the At-Taujih journal. The bibliography for the Journal of Islamic Guidance and Counseling uses the American Psychological Association (APA) 6th Edition style. Reference writing is preferably done using reference management applications such as Mendeley, EndNote, and Zotero.

Footnotes:

Footnotes must be used to provide explanations for the quotes used, written at the bottom of the text page as evidence of the reference source, using Garamond font size 10, 1.0 spacing.
