Hobbies

Pets/Animals

- Due to the influence of the virus, animals tend to avoid Steel.
- She's quite sympathetic to animals and never enjoyed the frequent testing done on them. In her mind, they're innocent of human evils.
- Infected animals will come near or obey Steel, like most other infected. She enjoys keeping Adjule and Cerberus.
- Steel is quite fond of the test animals and, despite detesting what they go through, does her best to keep them comfortable. She views this as a necessary evil.
- Rats seem to be undeterred by most infected, giving her the unique opportunity to interact with a "normal" animal. She quite likes them, and can sometimes be found playing with the friendlier lab rats.
- Steel is fond of amphibians and reptiles as well.

Humanity

- To her, humans are a lesser species, somewhat akin to how humans see apes.
- Though Steel deeply longs for the ability to connect with people, her traumatic upbringing and infection prevent her from forming any sort of real relationship with them. They are seen more as pets, at best.

- She doesn't want mass genocide for the sake of mass genocide; somewhat unlike Wesker, Steel sees the release of Uroboros as a necessary evil, rather than a desirable cleansing.
- Steel considers the virus as a byproduct of humanity's greed and nothing more. She feels humanity as a whole is at fault for the allowance of famine, disease, and war, where anything else is merely a symptom of the primary illness.

Caduceus (Cult)

Physiology

- Other infected (namely weaker t-variants) will be naturally inclined to obey Steel. The obedience is primal and pack-like, and results in Lickers, Hunters, Cerberus, and other t-virus infected individuals swarming her.
- The strongest of the infected are resistant to this control (Tyrants, most notably) and will instead either ignore her, aggress her as normal, or attempt to use her for reproduction (this is exclusive to those with a reproductive capability).
- In theory, Steel is genetically compatible with anything stemming from the Progenitor virus that is capable of reproducing sexually. This has not been tested.
- Estrus is triggered after her first pregnancy, and will be experienced between each subsequent pregnancy.
- When particularly threatened, frightened, or enraged, Steel's extremities begin to turn black and appear necrotic. They become rigid and claw-like, allowing for more damage to be done to an attacking target. These will eventually rot away, dropping off her and healing back into normal limbs. This is considered an instability within her variant of the virus.
- Drugs and poisons are almost completely ineffective against Steel, due to the presence of the virus. Ones made to target the virus may cause temporary damage (similar to [PG67A/W](#)'s effects on Wesker, unique to that drug), but will eventually be worked out of her system.
- All damaged tissue will heal in time. This is exclusive to injuries sustained *after* becoming infected (her vocal cords cannot heal/regrow because they were removed before the virus was introduced into her system).

- Due to the volatility of the young, Steel is unable to properly heal herself when pregnant. She is as susceptible to injury as any human, and severe enough harm will cause her body to shut down and miscarry.

Mental Health

- Steel suffers from several mental illnesses due to her upbringing.
- PTSD is the most notable; it can be triggered through threats of rape, telling her to “be quiet,” and several other similar things. Typically, someone threatening Steel in this manner will be killed immediately and without hesitation. Under the unique circumstance that she is, in fact, in danger, Steel will have a more “traditional” panic attack or breakdown.
- She has chronic nightmares, another symptom of her PTSD. Since drugs are ineffective, Steel has no proper way to treat this (or anything else).
