Concurrent Teaching @ WHS

Starting on Monday, 10/12 all staff can start using concurrent teaching with all their classes. A few things to keep in mind:

- All students are taking part via Meet (Full Roster) Hybrid & Full Time Remote Learners
- Attendance The teacher will be taking attendance for all students (In-person and Remote). Students will not be checking in via Genesis.
- Students in class should not be on camera
- The camera should focus on you or your shared screen/board
- Do not share personal student information during the class
- Use first names when calling on students in class or on the Meet

Prior to your first concurrent teaching lesson, please review the following with your students:

- What is <u>Concurrent Teaching</u>
- What will it look like
- Arriving on time
- Knowing what time math class is scheduled for each day
- This will not be a 64 minute Meet session
- Share how the class will be broken down
- Students should not be checking in via Genesis (The feature will still be on for other classes)
- Share how you will communicate with the at home learners (Chat, Remind, Classroom, Email, etc.) during the class period. Teacher choice on what works best for you.
- There will still be office hours available when needed

Before your first concurrent teaching lesson, you should experiment with:

- Where are you placing your Chromebook
- Sound check How far can you be from the Chromebook and can students hear you
- Do a demo run with one of your smaller classes
- Practice using the smartboard while on a Meet
