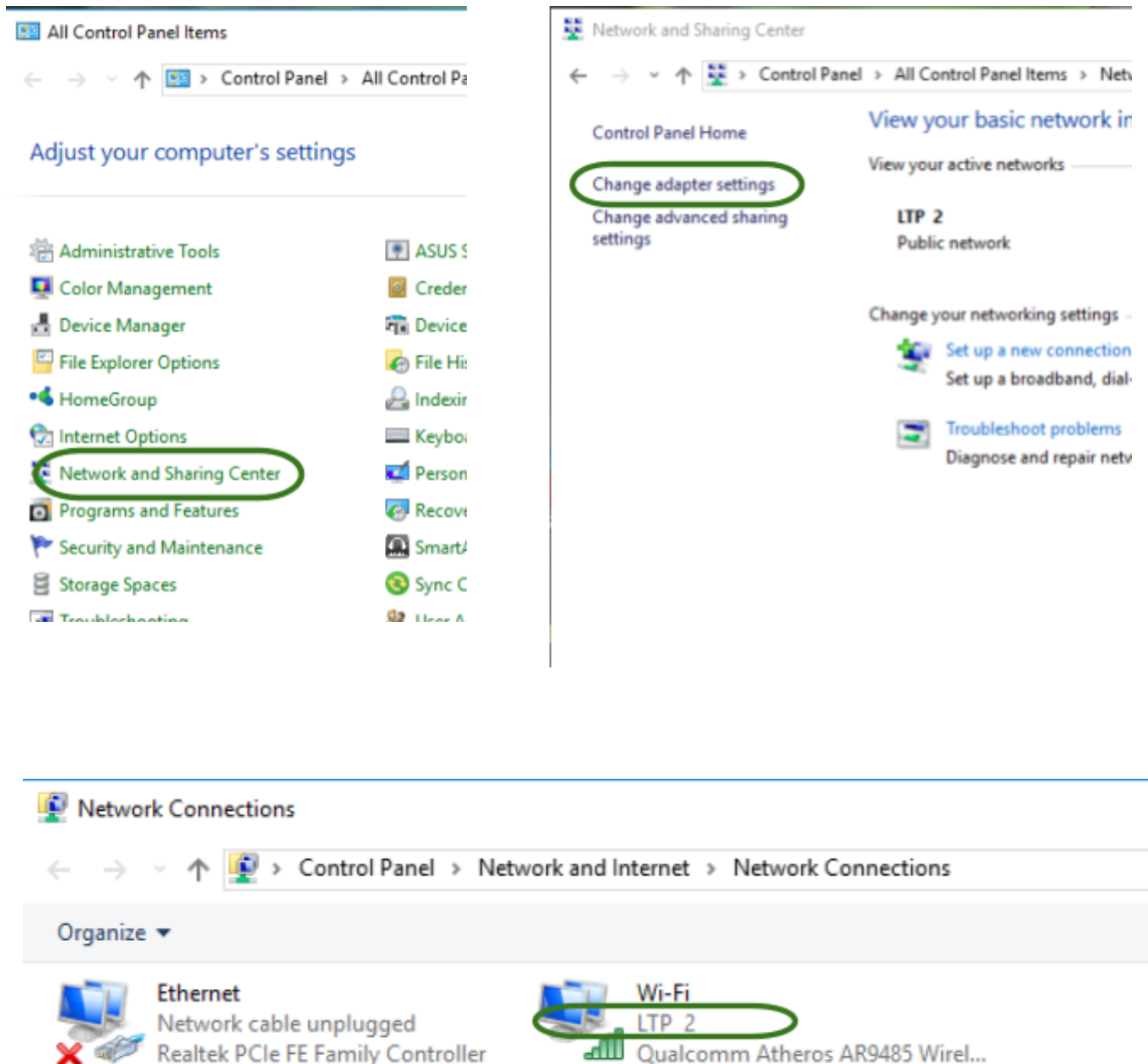


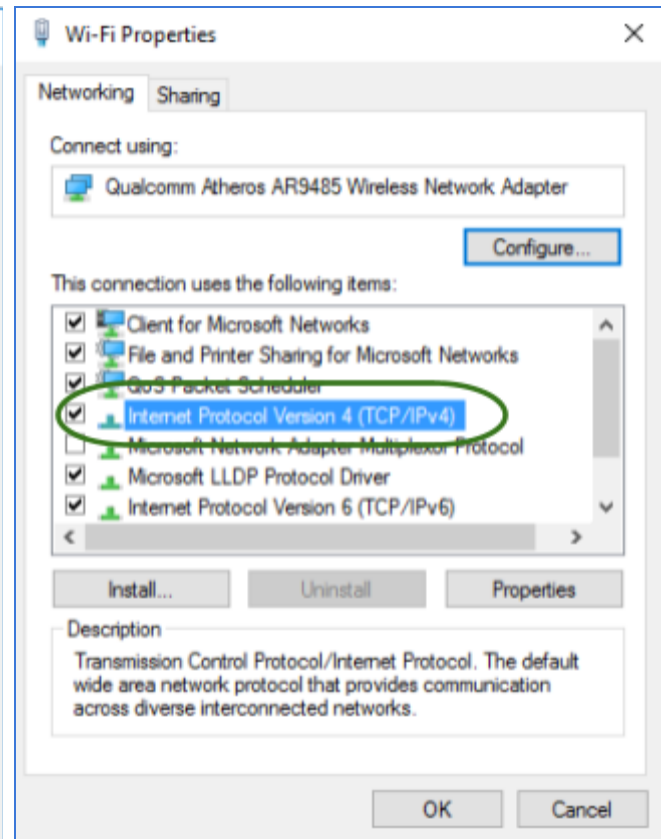
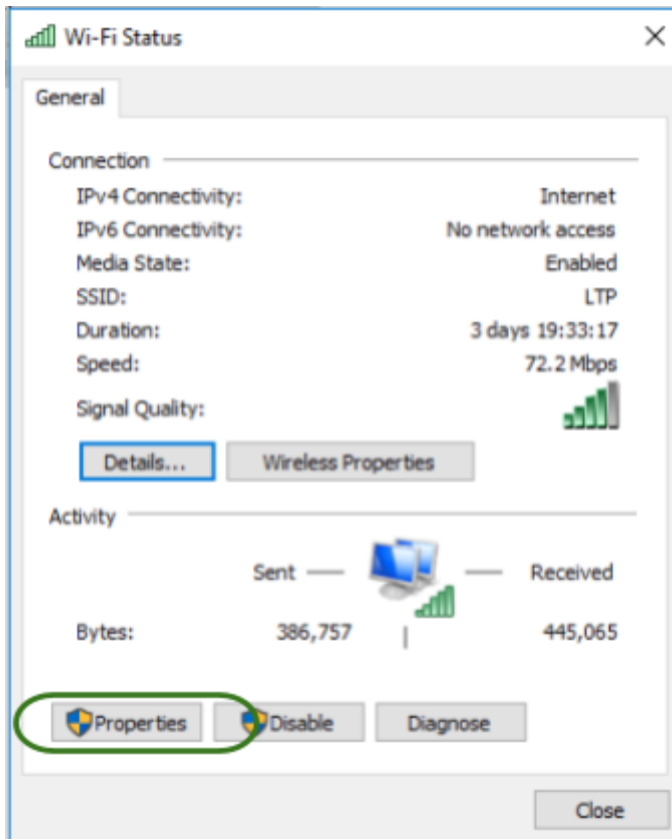
Set a Static IP Address for Windows

1. Access your computer's **Control Panel** to locate the **Network and Sharing** settings
2. Under **Change Adapter Settings** select your network named **LTP**



3. Select the **Properties** tab

4. Locate and select **Internet Protocol Version 4 (TCP/IPv4)**



5. Choose **Use the following IP address**

6. **IP address: 192.168.2.253**

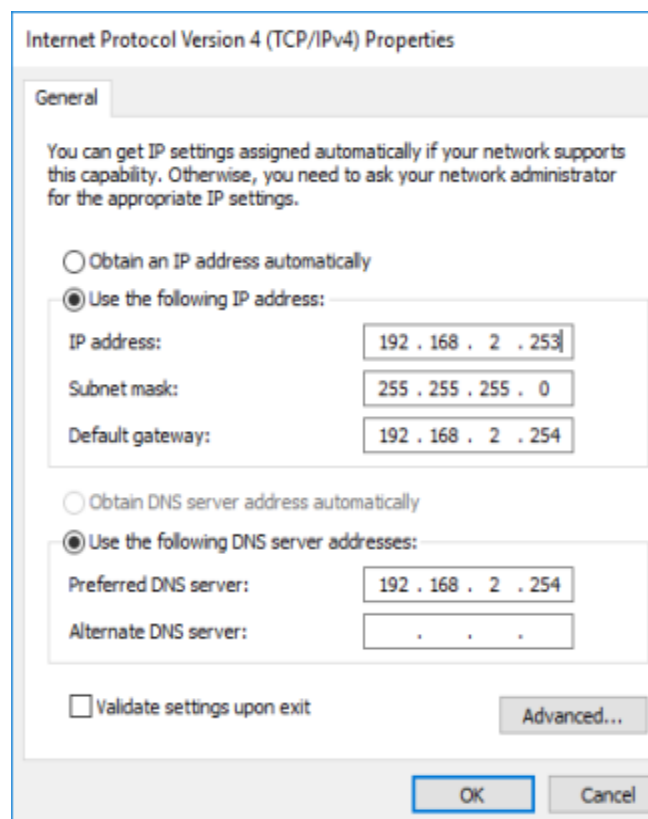
7. **Subnet mask: 255.255.255.0**

8. **Default gateway: 192.168.2.254**

9. Choose **Use the following DNS server addresses:**

10. **Preferred DNS server: 192.168.2.254**

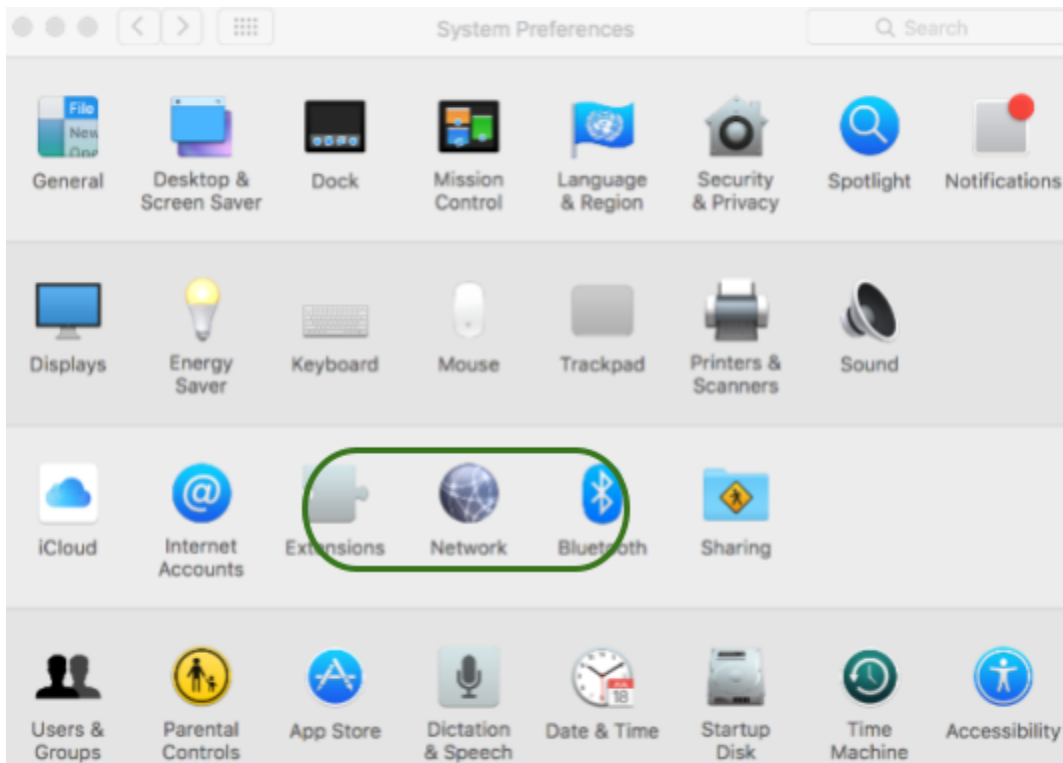
11. Click **OK** to save and exit



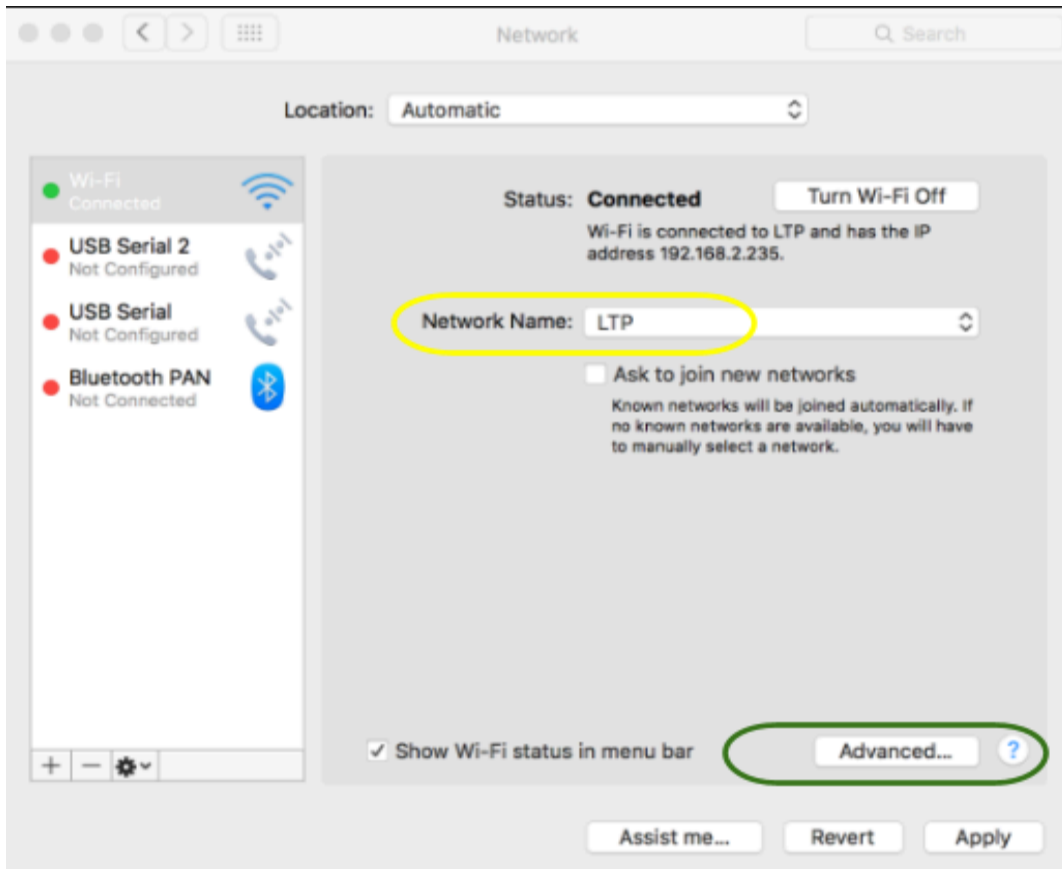


Set a Static IP Address for Macbook

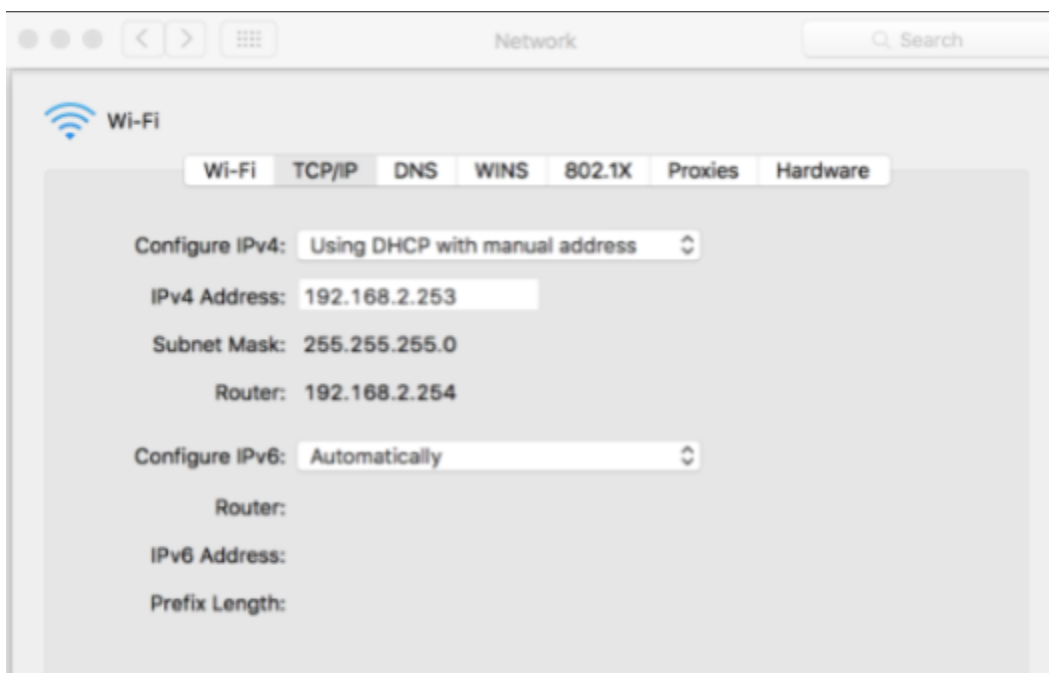
1. Access the Apple Menu and select ***System Preferences*** to locate the ***Network*** menu



2. Verify you are connected to the **LTP** network, and select **Advanced...**



3. Select the tab named **TCP/IP**
4. For **Configure IPv4** choose **Using DHCP with manual address**
5. Enter **192.168.2.253** for the **IPv4 Address**



6. Next choose the **DNS** tab
7. Select the plus icon furthest to the left
8. Enter **192.168.2.254** for the **DNS Server IP**
9. Click **OK** to save and exit
