Dog Registration:

Dogs must be registered with the North American Sport Dog Association. Registration is a one time fee of \$25.00. You may register your dog online at <http://nasda.dog/registration/>.

Rules:

For complete rules, visit nasda.dog UC Games Titles/Classes are as follows: UC1-Distance, UC2-You Make the Call, UC3-Elusive Rats, UC4-One or None, UC5-Silence, UC6-Roll of the Dice.

These games are similar to UL-II classes and are lots of fun! You should try them! 😊

We are also offering Lost Item Challenge Games on Saturday! LC1-Distance, LC2-You Make the Call And LC3-Elusive. As with the UC Games, These are similar to LI-II classes. And, as they are also “blind Hides”, you may only handle one dog in the class. If you have multiple dogs, you would have to have multiple handlers.

Please review all the rules on those as well, if you are not familiar with them.

Awards:

Ribbons are awarded for qualifying score (Q) and High in Class (HIC) and are self serve. Scores will be available at the conclusion of each class. New title ribbons or medals will also be available.

Please see Liz so we can celebrate with you and get you the proper ribbon or medal 😊

Venue: **Springhill Stables 5368 NW Springhill Drive Albany, OR 97321**

- Event grounds are on private property and are also part of a Boarding Stable/Equine Facility, and as such, by entering these grounds, you are bound by the Oregon Equine Inherent Risk Law (ORS 30.687 – 30.697). And by your presence on these grounds, you are agreeing to accept the limits of liability resulting from inherent risks of any activities involved on these grounds.
- You are Not allowed to enter any building other than the building in which the trial is being held. Do not attempt to pet or otherwise engage with any of the horses on the property. Please keep your dogs away from all horses, and do not allow them to bark at them or otherwise disturb them. Please do not take your dogs into the pool area (unless it is a part of a search area). Stay within the boundaries of the NASDA Trial areas.
- There are specific “Potty Areas” that will be marked for your convenience. Please do Not let the dogs potty Anywhere except for the designated areas (this includes not peeing On buildings in the gardens, etc). Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers.
- Please advise if you will have a BIS at the trial. BIS will have a separate parking and Potty Area.
- As indoor crating will be limited, Competitors are encouraged to crate out of their cars. (*Workers will get priority on indoor crating). If you do want to crate inside, please ask prior to just setting up. *We Love our volunteers, so please help out where you can. Thank you!
- The trial site is located 5 miles from town, so it is advisable to pack food and drink accordingly.
- Please do not drive on the grass. There is a one lane road for approximately 100 yards. Please be patient and if 2 cars are coming/going at the same time, Someone please back up. There is a pull off area outside of the gate (which will be open for this event), and the driveway splits into 3 as you get closer to the barns and house. Thank you for being respectful of my property!
- Parking will be in the “Outdoor Arena”. Please make the best use of the space. (For BIS, see Liz).
- **PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY! Speed Limit is 5 MPH.** Thank you! 😊

Trial Format:

- Friday/Sunday - We are Planning on Starting with Lost Item, Followed by Urban Locating and then UC Games.
- Saturday we will have a staggered earlier start with Lost Item at 8:30, with one judge, while the other judge will start the other classes at 9. We will likely start with Shed Dog, followed by Trailing Brace, and then Urban Locating after the field classes; however we will determine the order based on the weather (it is Spring in Oregon!). We will notify everyone several days prior to the trial of the Final Order for Saturday.
- **Please keep an eye out for the “judging program” and watch the SRP FB page for updates.**
- All classes will start with Puppy Aptitude. Trials 1, 2 and 3 for each class will be run back to back. Example: LI-I Trial 1, Trial 2, Trial 3; LI-II Trial 1, Trial 2, Trial 3; LI-III Trial 1, Trial 2, Trial 3. Teams will walk from the completion of Trial 1 to the start line of Trial 2, etc.
- There will be no resets for Level III trials this weekend.

Notice to Exhibitors:

- No refunds will be made for cancellations after the closing date or entries which are absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by decision of the Trial Committee.
- If necessary, and if eligible, Refunds will be mailed 7 days after the event.
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for behavior of their dogs, children and/or guests. Any exhibitor whose dogs, children and/or guests repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such a case, no refund on any entry will be made.
- All dogs must be on leash at all times except when competing.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being in the staging area when it is their turn to run.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A declined payment or returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$45 fee for any returned check or payment. Checks must be made payable to **Liz Couzin**. Also accepted:

We WILL be using Secreterrier Again for this trial. IF you enter THROUGH Secreterrier, there will be additional fees. IF you send your entry/payment to me, the rates are as listed on the entry form.

- **Urban Locating Challenge Games are blind hides - Therefore, handlers may not run more than one dog per game. So please make sure you are clear as to which dog you will be running. However... we Are Offering TWO trials of the UC Games Friday and Sunday!**
- **Friday & Sunday: Check-In begins at 8:30am Briefing is at 8:45. Trial begins with LI at 9:00. Saturday: Check - 8:00am Briefing - 8:15. Lost Item Begins at 8:30 - Other classes start at 9:00. Start times are subject to change depending on weather conditions or size of trial.**
The order of classes on Saturday (Shed Dog, TL Brace and Urban Locating will be based on weather). The week prior to the trial, we will email and post on the Springhill's Rat Pack Facebook page, the exact start time, so please be sure to check your confirmation or the FB page. Thanks! 😊
- **Classes will be run starting with Puppy Aptitude, going up in Level for each trial each day.**
