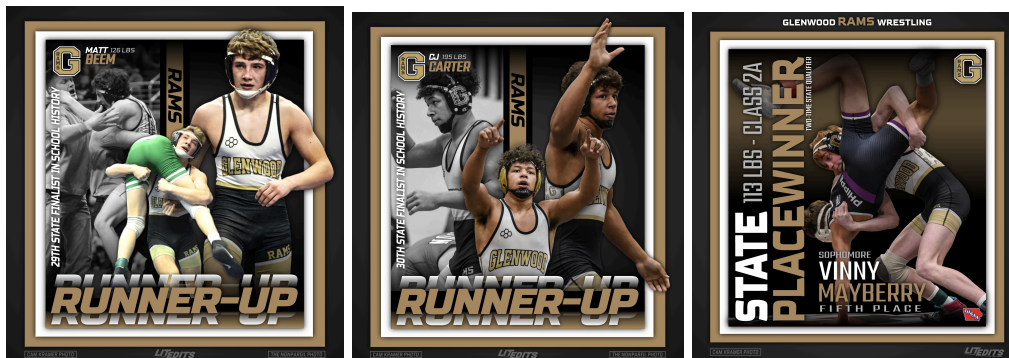


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Wrestling- Glenwood qualified 3 wrestlers for the State Wrestling Tournament. CJ Carter, Matt Beem both finished as State Runner Ups and Vinny Mayberry finished 5th. CJ Carter set a school record for most wins by fall and finished the year in 2nd for most wins in school history.



Boys Basketball- The boy's basketball team finished the year 10-11 and fell to Carroll in the first round of the post season tournament.

Swimming- Patrick Chase swam in 3 events at the State Swim Meet. Patrick finished 13th in the 100 freestyle.



Girls Basketball- The girl's basketball team finished the season 20-5 and ended their season at the State Tournament in the Semi-Finals. The senior class ends their career with an 85-15 record with 3 H-10 Championships & 3 State Tournament appearances.

Individual Speech- We had 16 contestants perform in 21 events and 19 advanced to State at ADM on March 12th.

Show Choir- Glenwood took 5th place at Lewis Central on March 5th. On February 22nd, Fastlane was Grand Champions at Wahoo. They also received Best Vocals, Best Choreography and Best Band. Both Glamour and Fast Lane have had a great Show Choir season and a big thanks to Mr. Kilpatrick for his leadership as well as all of our kids for their long hours put in to making them be the very best.

Jazz Band- Glenwood hosted the Dick Baumann District Jazz Festival on Presidents Day. The Jazz Band finished 2nd which qualified them for their 18th straight Iowa Jazz Championships.



Spring Sports- Boys & Girls track have started and the rest of the Spring sports will start March 14th.

Youth Art Month-March is Youth Art Month. Both Middle School and High School art students entered artwork to be judged into the YAM show. The Middle School had 4 students that were judged into the show, with one winning The Governor's Show Award: Scarlett Howard-"Lady of the Leaf.

The High School had 7 pieces from Terra Jensen, Ashley Aust, Lauren Culp, Aza Schetem, Addison Mitchell, and Olivia Compas judged into the show.
