Dear Wildcat Family,

Spring Break is March 16<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>. School will resume on Monday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>. There will be no school Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>. It is a Teacher Workday.

For the safety of all students, medication should never be sent to school with a child. A parent or guardian must bring all medications directly to the front office and complete a medical authorization form before any medication can be administered at school. All prescription medications must be in their original, labeled container. This policy applies to all medications, including allergy medicine, albuterol inhalers (unless a self-carry form is on file), eye drops needed during school hours, cough drops, and similar items. Students should also not bring vitamins to school, including gummy vitamins.

Now that the weather is getting warmer, we should review the ACPS Code of Conduct which states that shorts shall be worn no shorter than "mid-thigh". Mid-thigh is determined by extending the arms to the sides of the body and finding the tip of the longest finger." In relation to shoes, the Code of Conduct states, "you must wear shoes that are closed-toed and closed heel and/or athletic shoes" (no sandals, flip-flops, Crocs or jellies).

Students in fourth and fifth grades will begin Florida's B.E.S.T. Writing Assessment on Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup>. Teachers have been working hard all year to prepare the boys and girls for this important test. Here are some ways you, as a parent, can help your child do their very best on the test.
