- 8. How is this story like another story you have read, heard, or watched on TV?
- 9. Who is your favorite character in the story? Tell why they are your favorite using evidence from the text.
- 10. Which character or characters have changed in the story? How did he/ she change?
- 11. What does the main character/ characters learn in this chapter/ story?
- 12. What was your favorite part of the chapter or story? Use details from the text to explain why it is your favorite?
- 13. Is there anything you would change about the chapter or story? If so, what would you change?
- 14. Which character in the story would you most like to be and why?
- 15. Which character in the story would you like to be friends with and why?
- 16. What was your favorite part of the chapter or book? Explain why using evidence from the text.
- 17. What was your least favorite part of the chapter or book? Explain why using evidence from the text.
- 18. Is this story believable or not? Explain using evidence from the text.
- 19. Summarize what you read today. What were the important events? Did you learn anything new about the characters?
