Web App Design and Development Case Study - Auditions

Scenario: A high school theater program auditions students for a musical each year. Students sign up to audition online in a form that stores their name, address, student id, audition id, contact information, gender, desired role(s) and experience. At auditions, students are broken up into three groups based on their audition id number - an auto assigned number determined when they sign up. Girls with last names A-L start at 100, girls with last names M-Z start at 200 and boys start at 300.

In order to make efficient, data driven decisions, the students are evaluated in three areas (singing, acting, dancing). There are a total of nine judges, with three focused on each area. Each area's form has 5-7 categories(which can change from time to time) in which the judges score the students from 1-5, with five being the highest. Additionally, there is an area for notes about the students audition.

When a judge logs in, they are taken to the appropriate screen (their assigned area) where there exists a drop down list of the audition numbers of all the students that have signed up. Selecting an audition number is part of the form that they complete. Once a student has been scored by that judge, the student audition number no longer appears in the future drop downs of that judge.

There are also admins in this system that are able to access reports of the data. One type of report that can be accessed is a table of rankings from top to bottom. There are several of these reports that can be ordered by a single category or a combination of category scores. For example, the admin may choose to see the list in order of dance scores, dance and singing scores, or overall combined score. An auditionees score in an area is the average of the three judges total scores from that area turned into a percentage. The other type of report is an individual student report. In this report, the admin can see the student's basic contact information as well as their scores for music, acting, dance and overall. Additionally, their overall ranking appears next to their score. In further iterations of this report, admins can actually drill down to see the scores and comments from each judge in each category, including their comments (not part of this exercise).
