### WITH DAILY PRAYER TOPICS AND BIBLE READINGS

Dear Church Family

I am delighted to announce that at Monday evening's PCC meeting it was agreed that we will **re-start live Sunday** worship services at Emmanuel from 21<sup>st</sup> March.

We will need to have a number of safety measures in place (these include keeping 2 metres apart, lowering the capacity for the building, wearing face masks, and not singing or serving refreshments).

It was suggested at PCC that as a number of people in the church family will have had the vaccine that more people might want to attend live worship than in the autumn? Therefore we will be asking people to let us know if they are planning to come each Sunday. You can do this by emailing office@hawkwellparishchurch.org or phoning 01702 543514.

Please don't feel under any pressure to come along on Sunday mornings. We will continue to record and upload a service to YouTube each week.

As restrictions are gradually lifted we will continue to follow Church of England guidance on what measures need to be in place to keep everyone safe. We will also continue to review when it will be possible to re-open St Mary's for worship.

Please do continue to pray for all involved in decision making and preparing to open for live worship again. As we continue through Lent I do hope that you are finding the Bible Studies in the 'Giving God' booklets helpful. It would be really appreciated if you could return the 'Time and Talents' form and the 'Financial giving' forms by Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March so that they can included in the offetary for services on 21<sup>st</sup> March.

At the PCC meeting we also approved purchase of addition equipment to allow us to live stream and record our services at Emmanuel. Once the equipment is installed we will stop recording and editing a service in advance and instead allow access to a live stream and recording on YouTube of the Sunday service at Emmanuel.

I'm sure we are all hugely grateful for the vast amount of work that Pete Waters, Stephen Mountier and others have put into editing and putting together the recorded online service each week. When we started doing this last March we had no idea that we would still be doing this a year later. Thank you to everyone involved!!

The reason we are now purchasing the additional equipment is that we recognise that not everyone will be able or feel comfortable to return to live worship straight away. We will also continue to have church family members who are unwell or housebound in the future. It isn't realistic to continue to produce the recorded online service forever into the future.... But instead we will be enabling those who can't be there in person to join in the live stream - or watch a recording - of the Sunday service at Emmanuel.

It was mentioned at PCC that in the past gift days have had a 'focus'. The cost of the additional equipment is expected to be £3177. It would be fantastic if we were able to raise this in one off gifts and additional giving commitments on the  $21^{\rm st}$  March.

Please know that you all continue to be in my thoughts and prayers. We continue to look forward to the day when we will be able to all gather together and sing praises to Jesus our Lord and King.
