Feel free to buy from whatever store you would like. Some of the items you might already have at home, so please look around first before purchasing.

Items everyone needs to order or buy:

1. Air Dry Clay

1. Mini Rolling Pin (any rolling pin can work)

2. Parchment Paper or Wax Paper

3. Small, soft paint brush (round, flat or filbert)... does not need to be this nice, often these come in variety packs of 5

4. Small container for water
5. Small kitchen bowl for shaping
6. Any kind of knife (metal, plastic, Xacto)
7. Scissors
8. Leaf from outside: Should be a fresh (not dried or crumbly) leaf to impress into the clay. **Examples are in the photos below.** Any kind of leaf with an interesting shape and texture will work.
