

**7D7N WEST EUROPE (2TOGO)
BELGIUM-FRANCE-GERMANY-NETHERLAND**

Day 1 [Thursdays] Paris (26 km) → Versailles (26 km) → Paris

Your Parisian adventures start with a drive along **Champs Élysées** to **Place de la Concorde**. You'll see the iconic **Arc de Triumph** and **L'Hôtel National des Invalides**, where **Napoleon's tomb** is located. We will stop by the **Eiffel Tower**, the greatest icon of Paris. You can opt for going up to the Eiffel Tower for a breathtaking view of Paris. Or get some lunch around the neighbourhood. Then we will take you to **Palace of Versailles**, the former French royal residence and centre of government; **"The Hall of Mirrors"** is a must-see. We will get back to Paris for dinner before heading to the hotel. Overnight in Paris / nearby city (Don't miss taking an additional Paris by Night Excursion to explore Paris, the "City of Lights")

Day 2 [Fridays] Paris

We start with a visit to the **Louvre**, one of the largest museums in the world. You'll set your eyes upon world famous masterpieces including the Venus de Milo, the Winged Victory of Samothrace, and Mona Lisa by Leonardo da Vinci. Next, we will explore the **Seine** river. You can take a leisure cruise to see many iconic Parisian landmark like Notre-Dame Cathedral and Pont Alexandre III. Then experience Parisian shopping at famous department stores and have free activity time for the rest of the day; Add on: cabaret show, French dinner; Overnight in Paris / nearby city

Day 3 [Saturdays] Paris (144 km) → Reims (233 km) → Luxembourg

In the morning we set off to the capital of Champagne, Reims, also known as "the City of Kings". We'll visit the **Reims Cathedral**, where coronations of French kings took place from the 11th century onwards. Then we'll make our way to Luxembourg, the only Grand Duchy still extant in the world. Discover the beautiful sights of Luxembourg City centre, including the **Place de Constitution**, **Alzette Valley** and **Pont Adolphe**. Overnight in Luxembourg / nearby city

Day 4 [Sundays] Luxembourg (49 km) → Trier (130 km) → Koblenz (73 km) → Rudesheim am Rhein (66 km) → Frankfurt

We'll head to Trier, the oldest city in Germany. Known as 'The Second Rome' (Constantine served as an administrator for 10 years). Trier is also the birthplace of Karl Marx. You'll see the house in which Marx was born (**Karl Marx Haus museum**); And **Porta Nigra**, the best-preserved Roman city gate north of the Alps. Then head to Koblenz to see the **German Corner**, where the Rhine and Moselle River converge. You can add a scenic Rhine boat cruise (Depends on cruise availability & schedule, summer months only). Have a quick stop at **Rüdesheim am Rhein** and reach Frankfurt in the afternoon, visit **Römerberg** and **Paulskirche** (St. Paul's Church); Overnight in Frankfurt / nearby city

Day 5 [Mondays] Frankfurt (173 km) → Bonn (35km) → Cologne (261 km) → Amsterdam

We set off in the morning to Bonn, the former capital of West Germany, and birthplace of Beethoven. We'll visit **Beethoven Haus (Beethoven House)** & **University of Bonn**. Then head to Cologne to explore the **Gothic Cathedral**, a masterpiece of medieval European Gothic architecture and a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Next we'll have free activity time at the shopping street right next to the cathedral. We will make our way to the Netherlands after lunch. Overnight in Amsterdam / nearby city

Day 6 [Tuesdays] Amsterdam (Zaanse Schans)

A day of delights begins with a trip to **Zaanse Schans**. You'll see real windmills, visit a cheese farm and watch how they make cheese and see a wooden clog-maker in action. After lunch we will go to Amsterdam Centre and visit: **Dam Square**, **Royal Palace** & **National Monument**. You can take a canal cruise to discover Amsterdam's world-famous canals. Then visit a well-known **diamond factory**, and see the unique cutting techniques since 16th century. You can add an additional visit to Amsterdam Red Light District to satisfy your curiosity. Overnight in Amsterdam / nearby city; (During March to May, we'll add a visit to Keukenhof Garden Flower Exhibition, visit www.keukenhof.nl for details)

Day7 【Wednesdays】 Amsterdam (210 km) → Brussels (307 km) → Paris

In the morning we'll head south to Brussels, the capital of Belgium. The first stop in Brussels is **Atomium monument**. Follow by visiting Brussels city centre, **the Grand Place, the Town Hall**, and the famous impish **Manneken Pis statue**. After lunch, we will drive straight to Paris, France. We will get some dinner before heading to the hotel. Overnight in Paris / nearby city
