Digital Storytelling Activity 1

Finish the ending of 'Head to the Treehouse'

Task Instructions:

After reading the digital story 'Head to the Treehouse', you are to plan and create your own ending to the story using the platform Canva.

Consider the following questions:

- Will destroying the documents be enough to stop the apartment development?
- What else can the girls do to protect the parklands?
- What will the girls' dad say or do when he finds out the documents have gone missing?
- Has anyone been following Flo? If so, who and why?
- What would you do next if you were in Juniper and Flo's shoes?

Steps to complete this task:

- 1. Brainstorm all of your ideas and pick the best one!
- 2. On a piece of paper, plan how the narrative will end in as much detail as you can
- 3. Complete a storyboard of your ideas (see the template on the next page)
- 4. Use <u>Canva</u> to create your digital story
- 5. Export your video as an MP4 file or put into a <u>Google Slides</u> presentation

Tips and advice:

- Make sure that you use images, audio clips and video from Canva's content collection (don't take them off the internet as we don't have permission to use these)
- You might like to use some of your own photos or videos too!
- Please record your own audio narration
- Submit your finished digital story to the class <u>Google Drive folder</u>
