Day 01 MUNICH: All flights leads to Munich.

Today you embark on your tour when you board your flight to Munich. On arrival Check-in to your standard class hotel. Overnight at your standard hotel at Munich.

Day 02 SALZBURG: Munich guided city tour. Panoramic city tour of Salzburg.

Tour starts at 0900 hrs ----- Ends at 2000 hrs

(0900 hrs tour starts & end at 1230 hrs)After continental breakfast we discover city of Munich. During the Munich city tour we will learn about the origins of the old city in the middle ages, the monarchy, legends and fables, Bavarian culture, local cuisine and beer (of course) amongst many other things. Munich has many nicknames; "The Largest Village in Germany", "The Beer Capital of the World", "Athens on the Isar River", "The Northern most Village in Italy" and "The City of Festivals". All of these names are well deserved and the reason why on average 70 million people visit the capital of Bavaria each year! Munich is the unofficial beer capital of the world, home to the legendary Oktoberfest as well as hundreds of beer halls, gardens and cellars. Get a taste of Bavarian beer culture at its very best. Immerse yourself in the convivial atmosphere at a local beer hall; sip a stein at the renowned Hofbräuhaus; and learn about the techniques used to make Bavarian brew at the Beer and Oktoberfest Museum. (Depart at 1400 hrs & arrive Salzburg at 1530 hrs)Afterwards we shall move towards Salzburg. Enjoy a comprehensive overview of the city's history, architecture and culture as you pass top sites including Mozart's House, Salzburg Cathedral and Mirabell Palace. Soak up the stunning Baroque buildings and see iconic film locations from 'The Sound of Music.' Enjoy Indian dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight at standard hotel at Salzburg.

Day 03 VIENNA: Visit to Hallstatt. Orientation tour of Vienna.

Tour starts at 0830 hrs ----- Ends at 2000 hrs

(0830 hrs tour starts & arrive Hallstatt at 0930 hrs) After breakfast at hotel, gaze into your van as we shall proceed to Hallstatt. Discover the magic of the alpine region of Salzkammergut At Hallstatt, you have ample free time to take a walk along a lake in a historic village, see the Muhlbach Waterfall, visit the museums and the famous "Bone House," and more. (Suggested) You can also opt to take a ride cable car to the Hallstatt World Heritage Skywalk. (1400 hrs Depart & arrive Vienna by 1700 hrs) Later we shall proceed towards Vienna. On arrival we will take the orientation tour of Vienna. Highlights include Heldenplatz, Hofburg Palace, State Opera House, and Karlskirche. Orient yourself with the city so you're ready to explore like a pro. Indian dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight at standard hotel at Vienna

Day 04 Budapest: Imperial tour of Schoenbrumm Palace.

Tour starts at 0900 hrs ----- Ends at 2000 hrs

After continental breakfast ready to explore the Schoenbrunn Palace. Your chauffeur takes you from your hotel to the Schoenbrunn Palace, where you Stroll through the twenty-two state roms of the unique imperial summer residence at Schönbrunn.. (Suggested) Visit museums around Maria-Theresien-Platz, head for the Ring Road, which borders the historic city center. On the way, pass the neo-Gothic Town Hall and the impressive Austrian Parliament Building. Continue through the Volksgarten, check out Heroes Square, and pass the Hofburg Palace. Listen to your guide's

commentary on the history, culture, and people of Vienna as you walk around Burggarten, the former Emperor's private garden, and the Augustinian Church. End with visits to St. Stephen's Cathedral, the Vienna State Opera, and the bustling Graben shopping street. Your tour ends at St. Stephen's Cathedral, Vienna's most famous landmark; you are free to explore further on your own from there. (Deaprt at 1700 hrs and arrive by 1900 hrs)Later move towards Budapest. On arrival enjoy Indian food. Overnight at standard hotel at Budapest.

Day 05 BRATISLAVA: Panoramic city tour of Budapest.

Tour starts at 0900 hrs ----- Ends at 2000 hrs

(0900 hrs tour starts) After continental breakfast we proceed on a (Suggested) guided walking tour as you pass Vajdahunyad Castle, the Opera House, and the Parliament Building. In the Heroes' Square, admire the statues of the Seven Chieftains of the Magyars as well as the sweeping views of the city from the Fisherman's Bastion along with the waters of the Danube. Learn all about Budapest's rich history and its architectural gems from your local guide as you travel between the major attractions. After your sightseeing tour enjoy free time to explore the city on your own and to taste local Hungarian cuisine. (Depart at 1730 hrs & arrive Bratislava by 1900 hrs) Continue your journey towards Bratislava. Enjoy Indian food at Indian restaurant. Overnight at standard hotel at Bratislava

Day 06 PRAGUE : Guided city tour of Bratislava.

Tour starts at 0900 hrs ----- Ends at 1700 hrs

After breakfast at hotel take panorama city tour of Bratislava, pass along Presidential Palace, continue to a district full of villas built in funcionalism style Palisady, visiting imeprial Bratislava Castle & Slovak Parliament and finish panorama city tour by visiting Slavin Monument from where is a breathtaking view on Bratislava. Continue the Private Grand City Tour by walking part in a historical city center of Bratislava. You will discover with us all main highlight of historical city center of Bratislava such as Slovak National Theatre, building of Slovak Filharmony Orchestra - Reduta, Man at Work statue, Main Square with Roland Fountain, statue of Napoleon soldier & Old Town Hall, hidden gem of Bratislava - Primate's Palace, continue to St. Michael's Gate, Palace of Royal Hungarian Chamber, Mozart House, Academia Istrpolitana and end of the tour at St. Martin's Cathedral. (Depart at 1400 hrs & arrive Prague by 1700 hrs)Continue your journey towards Prague. Overnight at standard hotel at Prague.

Day 07 PRAGUE: Guided city tour of Prague. Vltava river cruise.

Tour starts at 0900 hrs ----- Ends at 2000 hrs

After breakfast start your day by exploring the UNESCO-listed historic center, passing monuments such as the Powder Gate, the Astronomical Clock, and the Old Town Square. Then, stroll

through the Jewish Quarter, or head down to Wenceslas Square and the New Town to admire architectural gems such as the National Theatre, the New Town Hall, and the unique 'Dancing House'. Pose for photos on the famous Charles Bridge and take in the views along the VItava River as you cross into the Lesser Town, then hear more about Prague's rich history as you wander the maze-like streets and visit the legendary John Lennon Wall. Escape the crowds to walk around the hilltop Petrin Park, where you could climb the Petrin Tower for a spectacular view over the city or take a tour of the Strahov Monastery (own expense). Don't miss the city's star attraction - Prague Castle, one of the world's biggest castle complexes, where you'll see Gothic and Renaissance masterpieces such as St Vitus Cathedral, Hradcani Castle, and the Golden Lane. Later enjoy VItava river cruise. Indian dinner at Indian restaurant. Overnight at standard hotel at Prague.
