All registration for school will be completed online through Infinite Campus. When you log in to the parent portal, click on the three horizontal lines in the upper left-hand corner, select "more" on the left side, and you will see the online registration link as one of your selection possibilities. If you have already completed registration and just need to pay fees, go back to the three lines again and select "fees".




