

8608 Student Expectations when coming in

1. Class and events will be sensory overload as they are bright and loud. Quiet areas are often provided by us and event organizers, please be aware.
2. Bring a windows pc laptop.

4. Phones will be put into a bucket upon arrival, so your child may not respond immediately.
5. During the off-season is when skills are LEARNED, during the competition season is when skills are APPLIED. Students have ignored the off-season and felt "left out" during the rush of the on-season, do not let this happen to you!
6. "I don't know" is not an excuse to not try. It's the only reason you are here. "I don't know" is why you need to keep trying.
7. This class is CHALLENGING. Its meant to challenge the students.
 - a. It is NOT "Do A then B then C". this is not about "following mentors directions"
 - b. This will sometimes create a "lost" feeling if the students do not listen to mentors and seek out the answers to their questions.
 - c. We most often will provide tools and skills to search, find, ask, locate, read or figure out How to accomplish Any task. i.e Google "how to create a video for a class" or ChatGpt some code examples.
 - d. Mentors will always help students but some students are very programmed to be told the "correct" way forward and we will do our best to teach students a new way forward

8. We do not Give “opportunities” out, This class is the “opportunity”
 - a. Students are part of a TEAM, sometimes you tighten a bolt, sometimes you design the exciting new feature that gets us to worlds. Students MUST see personal growth as a success, not just “being the quarterback”.
