Dear Incoming Kindergarten Families:

To better meet the needs of our kindergarten families with full-day childcare needs, we have annually partnered with our local park districts to offer half-day afternoon childcare (known as C.A.R.E.). These programs are both convenient and provided at a low cost to D15 families.

Historically, students enrolled in the program attend morning kindergarten at a District 15 school and are transported to a park district facility for half-day afternoon childcare.

As you might imagine, there are limitations that we face each year with the current CARE, model:

- 1. Placement in the program fills quickly; and
- 2. In order to utilize the half-day childcare program, students must be placed in a morning kindergarten section, which cannot always be guaranteed based on space limitations.

In order to increase childcare options for our kindergarten families, The Palatine Park District will be offering a *morning half-day childcare option* in addition to the longstanding afternoon program offering. We hope you are as excited about this addition as we are. This additional option will allow afternoon kindergarten students to receive a full day of care, allow more families to take advantage of the program and eliminate enrollment stressors placed on schools in the past.
