General Meeting Minutes - 3.14.24 - Approved by C. Green, seconded by A. Pappas

President's Report (B. Bressler)

1. Focused Recognition: Sean Markee for help with the turf, Andrew Pappas for help with fields and painting, Anthony Gencarelli for running umpire clinic, and those who helped with the turf prep/paint.
2. D21 Update: sent over Jr/Sr baseball and softball to LC, LL goal is to merge teams to make fewer better organizations. We are hosting Districts for 8-10, 9-11, and 10-12 year old divisions (6/21-7/11). Still contemplating hosting sections for 8-10 (7/13-7/17).
3. Morrisville Borough: water has been turned on in the park.
