

## **Amesbury School Netball Sign Up Year 3-6 2019**

### **REGISTRATION FORM**

**Registrations will close Friday 22 February.**

Please note: This netball registration is *just for Year 3-6 students (girls and boys)*. Registrations for Year 1 and 2 will be collected later in the year.

All teams will be 6 aside so we will aim for no more than 9 players per team.

We are going to run 'competitive' and 'social' teams this year.

**Competitive teams:** There will be trials for the competitive team. Trials will be in the last week of February if needed. Decisions for the competitive teams will be made by Georgia. There will be a training once a week for this team. This training will be to focus on developing skills and practicing plays. You will still play a range of positions as primary school netball is still about developing an interest in the sport.

**Social teams:** There will be no trials for the social teams. These teams will also have a practice. The focus for these teams is developing an interest and love of the sport.

**Cost:** The fees for 2019 remain the same as 2018 which is approximately \$55.

**Uniforms:** Year 5 and 6 Students will need to have an Amesbury school sports top and will be provided with a skirt. Year 3 and 4 students will need to be in appropriate sportswear and shoes, but do not need an Amesbury School sports top.

**We will need a coach, a manager and an umpire for each team (even the social teams).** I will not be coaching or managing any netball teams, so if we do not have parent help, we will be unable to run teams.

### **Coaching Y5/6 teams**

Job descriptions:

Coaches:

- To ensure the students experience enjoyment while training and playing the game
- To organise a training day if appropriate for your team (these can be help during lunchtimes or after school)
- Organise warm ups, drills, activities and games for trainings and games
- Be there for all the games/ trainings or organise for the manager to fill in
- Look after the team balls, bib and other gear
- To give all students a fair turn on the court
- To ensure students are trying out and experiencing all the positions
- Feedback to students about their game is positive and constructive
- Check the games timetable and let the students and parents in your team know the appropriate information for the game
- Check cancellations

**Star Helpers (coaches) Year 3/4 Teams**

Star helpers are like the coach for the Year 3 and 4 teams. You will be required to attend a Star Helpers Workshop (date to be confirmed) which will teach you how to run the Saturday drills/ games. You will be required to be on the court on Saturdays to help. The Saturday will be both the training and the game (there will be no other training in the week).

**Managers:**

- To support the coach
- Turn up to all the games
- Check the games timetable and let the students and parents in your team know the appropriate information for the game
- Check cancellations
