
If you get the pop-up that says, "Do you want to map a Google Drive?" Click YES!



### PLEASE!

When using ParentSquare to communicate with Guardians, make sure you include ALL GUARDIANS LISTED for a student. When you create and share a POST, all guardians are automatically notified. But, when you send a message, you have to click on each guardian separately. If a guardian is listed, they should be notified. Some teachers have accidentally left off guardians resulting in miscommunications.





### Remember!

Your GoGuardian classes are linked to your SchoolTool rosters. All of your classes will be automatically pulled into GoGuardian (and updated as SchoolTool updates!). When you log in to GoGuardian, click on the "Pending" option on the left side. From there, you can accept any/all the classes you need! Fall and Spring semester courses will be listed, so don't get overwhelmed if you teach both and it seems like there are too many classes. You do not have to accept them all now, just remember you will have to before the spring semester beings!

Please remember when you are getting your **Google Classroom** ready, you can pre-populate and link it to your **SchoolTool** roster. This makes pulling grades from Google Classroom simple! **This is for teachers in grades 2-12.** For those of you who are unsure how to do this, or do not remember, here is my <u>Google Classroom & SchoolTool Sync "How-To."</u>








Rage Against the Machine never specified what type of machine they were furious with but I reckon it was probably a printer.
