

Are You Facing Housing Challenges?

We understand that some families may be experiencing difficulties with stable housing. The McKinney-Vento Act assists children and youth who lack "a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence". This federal law ensures that students facing housing insecurity can continue their education without interruption.

If you or someone you know qualifies under the McKinney-Vento Act, we can offer support with:

- Clothing
- School fees
- Personal hygiene items
- Nutrition programs
- Transportation

Even if you don't meet the specific criteria for the McKinney-Vento Act, we may still be able to assist you with referrals for housing services, medical/dental/vision care, documentation assistance, and food security programs.

Please contact Mr. Roden, our School Social Worker and Homeless Liaison, for a confidential needs assessment. If your child was eligible last year, please reach out to reassess your current needs and update your status.

All personal information will be kept strictly confidential. There will be no record in your child's file, and only a limited number of staff members will be aware of your situation. Your child's education and well-being are our top priorities. Don't hesitate to reach out – we're here to support you and your family.
