Booster seats provide an extra step between child s	afety seats and seatbelts.		
Kentucky Booster Law states that "Any driver of a motor vehicle, when transporting a child <b>under the age of eight (8) years who is between forty (40) inches and fifty-seven (57) inches in height</b> in a motor vehicle operated on the roadways, streets, and highways of this state, shall have the child properly secured in a child booster seat. A child of any age <b>who is greater than fifty-seven (57) inches in height</b> shall not be required to be secured in a child booster seat under this section. If a child is <b>older than 8 years old or over 57 inches tall</b> , they are not required by law to ride in a booster seat."
