Misses her</p> <p>Page 30 -radio says, “war may be declared any hour. This country stands ready to defend its...” -firemen sit around playing cards and smoke pipes -all the firemen have the same look: dark hair, dark eyes, bluish cheeks -Montag also looks just like that</p> <p>Page 31 -a man from a fire last week was put in an insane asylum -Beatty says any man who thinks he can fool government is insane -There’s a type list of millions of forbidden books posted at firehouse -Montag keeps remembering something in his ventilator and talking to a man in a park a long time ago</p> <p>Page 31 Stoneman and Black: other firemen -according to firemen history books: Ben Franklin was first fireman and started it to burn English books in the colonies, firemen always burned -alarm sounds -“orange dragon” is their firetruck</p>
