I give each post a title and I label it so that my work is easy to find. For example if I post a poem I label it, '<i>Explanation, Writing, Jaydon, 2017</i>' so that people searching for my explanation can find it quickly. There is comments section under each post. This also makes your blog is unique because it allows people to give comments and information that is special to you about your learning.
