NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Hornell Board of Public Safety hereby approves the hiring of Michael Hoyt and Peter McDaniels as Hornell Police Department patrolmen from the Civil Service eligibility list, and Brett Flaitz as Hornell Police Department patrolman as a transfer from the Steuben County Sheriff's Department; and.,
