Roosevelt Jr. High School 6th Grade Music Course Options

Beginning Band

Beginning Band: Students will be taught how to play a band instrument of their choice: Clarinet, Flute, Baritone, Tuba, Trombone. Students will learn how to read music, use proper posture to play an instrument, and learn how to perform in a band setting. Students will participate in at least three concerts during the school year.

Beginning Orchestra

Students will be taught how to play a string instrument: the bass, viola, cello, or violin. Students will learn how to read music, use proper technique to play an instrument, and learn how to perform in an orchestra setting. Students will participate in at least three evening concerts during the school year. Rental or purchase of an instrument, and purchase of a book used in class are required. Prior to the start of the school year, parents and students will be invited to an orchestra night where they will find out the proper size and kind of instrument and have the opportunity to rent an instrument.

Mixed Chorus

This course is open to students who are interested in developing their musical skills through singing. Students will learn how to read music, use proper posture, and learn how to perform in a choir. Students will participate in one concert per quarter during the year.
