If several people wish to speak, each person will be allotted 3 minutes until the total time of 30 minutes is used. Each person addressing the Board will give his/her name and address. During that period, no person may speak twice until all who desire to speak have had the opportunity to do so. Persons desiring to speak can indicate their desire by filling out a blue card and presenting it to the Board President prior to the opening of the meeting.
