COMES NOW John Doe of 000 Road 00, Worland, County of Washakie, State of Wyoming, and the J.W. Doe Irrigation District, acting through its Chairman, Buck Doe, of Route 0, Box 000, Worland, County of Washakie, State of Wyoming, whom being duly sworn on oath according to law does hereby make the following statement of facts and petition:

- 1. THAT John Doe is the present owner of the lands to which a portion of the appropriation involved in this petition are attached, said lands being located within the boundaries of the J.W. Doe Irrigation District, as evidenced by the copy of Warranty Deed from the County Clerk of Washakie County, Wyoming.
- 2. THAT the appropriation for which a change in place of use is sought is the J. W. Doe Appropriation, Permit No. 7609, adjudicated under Proof No. 28250½, in the amount of 2.26 c.f.s. for the irrigation of 158.5 acres, diverting from No Name Creek, tributary No Name River, through the No Name Canal, with priority of April 9, 1902, and of record in Order Record 17, page 352; Certificate Record 68, page 310 describing the lands irrigated as follows:

3. THAT your petitioners desire to redescribe J.W. Doe Appropriation, Permit No. 7609, Proof No. 28250½, so as to set out the lands to be irrigated as follows:

Township 46 North, Range 92 West, 6 th P.M., Independent Resurvey		
Section 6	Tract 38F:	23.0
	Tract 38G:	39.0
	Lot 8:	32.3
	Lot 9:	26.0
	Lot 10:	<u>38.2</u>
	Total:	158.5 acres (2.26 c.f.s.)

4. THAT the reason for this change of place of use is due to the slope and type of soil in the area, which leads to excessive erosion when flood irrigated. The petitioners are replacing the flood irrigation system with a center pivot sprinkler system to alleviate the erosion problem and to reduce labor costs.
5. THAT recording fees in the amount of \$50.00 accompany this petition.
6. THAT a properly prepared map showing the actual situation on the ground accompanies this petition.
7. THAT the granting of this petition will not injury any other appropriators.

It is the prayer of your petitioner that a proper Order of the State Board of Control be entered to change the place of use for the lands to be irrigated under a portion of the J.W. Doe Appropriation, as shown in Paragraph 3 above, be granted and that a proper order of the Board be entered recording the same.
