

# 2026 S P Mittal & Family Scholarship for STEM Majors

**Submission Deadline: Wednesday, April 15, 2026 at 11:59pm Pacific Time**



The S P Mittal & Family Scholarship is funded through the generosity of a former Monte Vista family, to help a Monte Vista student follow their dream of pursuing a degree in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM).

This scholarship will award **\$2,500** to **one (1) graduating student**, based upon the application criteria below.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants must:

- Be a current Monte Vista High School senior
- Be a MVHS PTSA Student or Family Member (Uncertain if you are a PTSA member? Contact [Elizabeth Yuan](#), MVHS PTSA Scholarship Chair, to verify. To become a member, go to [MV Future Fund](#) to purchase your student membership. If the membership fee presents a financial hardship, please contact Ms. Mooney at [amooney@srvusd.net](mailto:amooney@srvusd.net).)
- Have demonstrated interest in a STEM field while in high school
- Be accepted into and plan on full-time attendance at a 4-year college/university, pursuing a major in STEM
- Have a minimum unweighted GPA of 3.5

## **How to Apply**

Provide the following items by the submission deadline:

1. Submit [application form](#). You will be prompted to upload the items listed below in the last section of the form.
2. Personal Statement (maximum of 650 words) that addresses **all** of these questions:
  - *What has sparked your interest in/passion for STEM, and how have you pursued its study/application while at Monte Vista?*
  - *How do you plan to use your STEM degree after your college graduation? How do you anticipate your studies will help you make a meaningful impact?*
3. Copy of your mid-year transcript
4. Letter of Recommendation (LOR) from a MVHS reference (teacher, athletic coach or counselor). If LOR is not available at the time you submit your application, please email the LOR to Ms. Mooney at [amooney@srvusd.net](mailto:amooney@srvusd.net) within 5 days of the application deadline.

The scholarship recipient will be notified in advance of the Senior Award Ceremony where the recipient will be recognized. All applications are confidential and are only shared with the PTSA Scholarship Committee and MVHS Counseling Office.
