CHARACTER:

Create a character in the same style but make her a blonde woman

STYLE LOCK – NON-NEGOTIABLE

Create a YouTube thumbnail in the exact visual language of a clean, high-contrast, finance-explainer cartoon thumbnail system. The style must be simple, bold, flat-shaded, mobile-first, and instantly readable at small size. Use a bright white or very light gray background with minimal texture, almost no visual noise, and large empty negative space for oversized headline text. CLOTHING (IF RELEVANT)

Default clothing is a teal/green short-sleeve collared shirt with simple folds and flat shading. Alternate version for authority/status contrast may be a dark suit, white shirt, and black tie. Clothing should communicate approachable middle-class finance explainer energy, not luxury fashion. Keep materials simplified and matte. No logos, no patterns, no realistic fabric texture. TEXT STYLE

Text must be huge, bold, uppercase, condensed sans-serif, black by default, arranged in stacked blocks on one side of the thumbnail. COMPOSITION RULES

Use a strict mobile-first composition. One character, one headline block, one main symbolic finance graphic cluster. Follow rule of thirds with either:

character on left + text on right + symbol between/below,
or text on left + character on right + symbol in center/lower area.

Leave generous negative space so every element reads instantly. Focal point must be split between the character's face and the headline text, with the finance symbol acting as supporting evidence. Every object must earn its place and support the headline.

FORMAT & QUALITY
