LHCC Community Grant Restrictions

- The Community grantee must not use funds to discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, veteran status, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, or any other basis of discrimination prohibited by law.
- Funds cannot be used for food, salaries, lobbying, or office supplies, such as computers, chairs, etc.
 - Materials for the program, intervention or campaign are allowed, such as printing, paint, etc.
 - Education activities about policies are allowed but not for personnel or curriculums.
- Eligible organizations: non-profits (with 501c3 status), government entities (e.g. village, town, city, or parish governments), universities, schools, and other community-based organizations. (e.g. community health centers, FQHCs, or churches).
- This Community grant does not fund individuals but are welcome to partner with an eligible organization.
- Organizations are encouraged to partner with a local coalition for their community grant.
- Applications may be limited to one organization per grant cycle per focus area.
- Work funded by the community grant must be completed in the State of Louisiana.
- Grantees must have projects complete by May 31, 2024.
