







Ensure your student's success by... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Setting up a good night routine; consistent bedtime, lay clothes out, set an alarm clock ● Waking up early and allowing plenty of time to get to school to avoid the "rush" ● Communicating with the school when your student is going to be absent; phone call or send a note

Practice identifying individual letters and sounds they make 2. Listen to nursery rhymes, such as Hickory Dickory Dock 3. Encourage reading at home 4. Encourage your student to read words they see around the house or when you are out of the house. 5. Ask your students questions about what they have just read.
