Appendix C: Findings from the Bonneville Communities That Care (BCTC) Participant Group

There were 12 participants that completed the survey from the BCTC area. Given the small sample size results do not represent the greater BCTC area. This appendix provides a brief summary of findings from the BCTC group as well as the item frequencies for each item on the survey.

All twelve participants were White, two participants also indicated that they were Asian, and one was Hispanic/Latino. On average participants completed MyDD with 4 children, most of which were under five years old.

A little less than half the participants were participating in both the Discovery Family Adventures and the Summer Passport 2021 programs. The Summer Passport hubs joined included: Box Elder, Weber/Davis, and Tooele. Half of the participants learned about MyDD through Facebook, which is also the most common platform used to learn more about or participate in MyDD. Two-thirds of participants did not have any trouble using any of the platforms. The program characteristic that was the most helpful was the flexibility to do the adventures on their own schedule and the most common barrier was scheduling conflicts. On average, participants started 21 adventures and completed 16. Participants enjoyed the camping, hiking, and laser tag adventures.

On average, participants completed *most* of the adventures as a family, read *most* of the informational content, and all of the participants found the information to be useful. Approximately half of the participants were not aware that there were prizes or what they were. As a result of the adventures most of the participants have spent more time doing activities together with their families.

Overall, participants felt that the adventures made them feel a *little* more connected to their children and a *little* more motivated to spend free time with their children. Almost all BCTC participants were very satisfied with the adventures they did and would recommend MyDD to others.
