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King's College will not reopen for scholars until January 1st, despite no longer being used as a military hospital. All patients were transferred to other centers during October. Mr. A. E. Wood, the Director of Education, informed us this morning that the Education Department does not propose to recall students before the new year.

The College is currently undergoing rehabilitation following the military's departure. Even if the work is completed long before the New Year, Mr. Wood believes it would be inadvisable to disrupt current arrangements. King's College students were absorbed into other schools, with the majority attending Queen's College and the Ellis Kadoorie School. Pupils will commence the new term at King's College after the New Year.
