District Banner Competition Rules

(updated 2026)

The District Banner is due at Grand Floor practice before Grand Assembly.

This banner will be carried by a member of your District in the march of the Mother Advisors and Worthy Advisors (or escort of Mother Advisor's choice if Worthy Advisor is not available).

The lineup is by District, and then by Assembly number.

Banner Must:

1. Measure 15 inches wide by 24 inches high.
2. Have a 1 inch casing at the top (included in the 24 inch height) for the pole to go through.
The pole is furnished by Grand Assembly, and will be the property of Grand Assembly, to be retained for use each year at Grand Assembly.
3. Show your District number in the center.
4. Include the Assemblies in your district.
5. No border trim (such as lace, fringe, etc.) that would extend the size of the banner or make it 15 inches in width.
6. May be your own idea, no restriction as to the material, decorate it as you wish.
7. You may get help from your Assembly in making your banner - adults may not participate.

The banners will be judged on the following: Received on time, size, creativity, neatness, and overall impression.

They will be on display in the Grand Assembly room during session and picked up at the end of Grand Installation.
