
# **TSI Testing Information**

The TSI Assessment (TSIA) is part of the Texas Success Initiative program designed to determine if you are ready for college-level coursework in the areas of reading, writing, and mathematics. If you'd like to take college courses in high school or plan to go to college or university after you graduate, you are required to take the TSI Assessment - unless you are already exempt to determine your readiness for college-level work. Based on how you perform, you may either be enrolled in a college-level course and/or be placed in the appropriate developmental course or intervention to improve your skills and prepare you for success in college-level courses.

The TSIA2 consists of three examinations – Mathematics, English Language Arts and Reading (ELAR), and Essay. The TSIA2 is known as an adaptive test. What does this mean? The test gives you questions based on how you answer the ones that came before to figure out which skills you have and which ones you don't. Qualifying college ready scores are below. 
