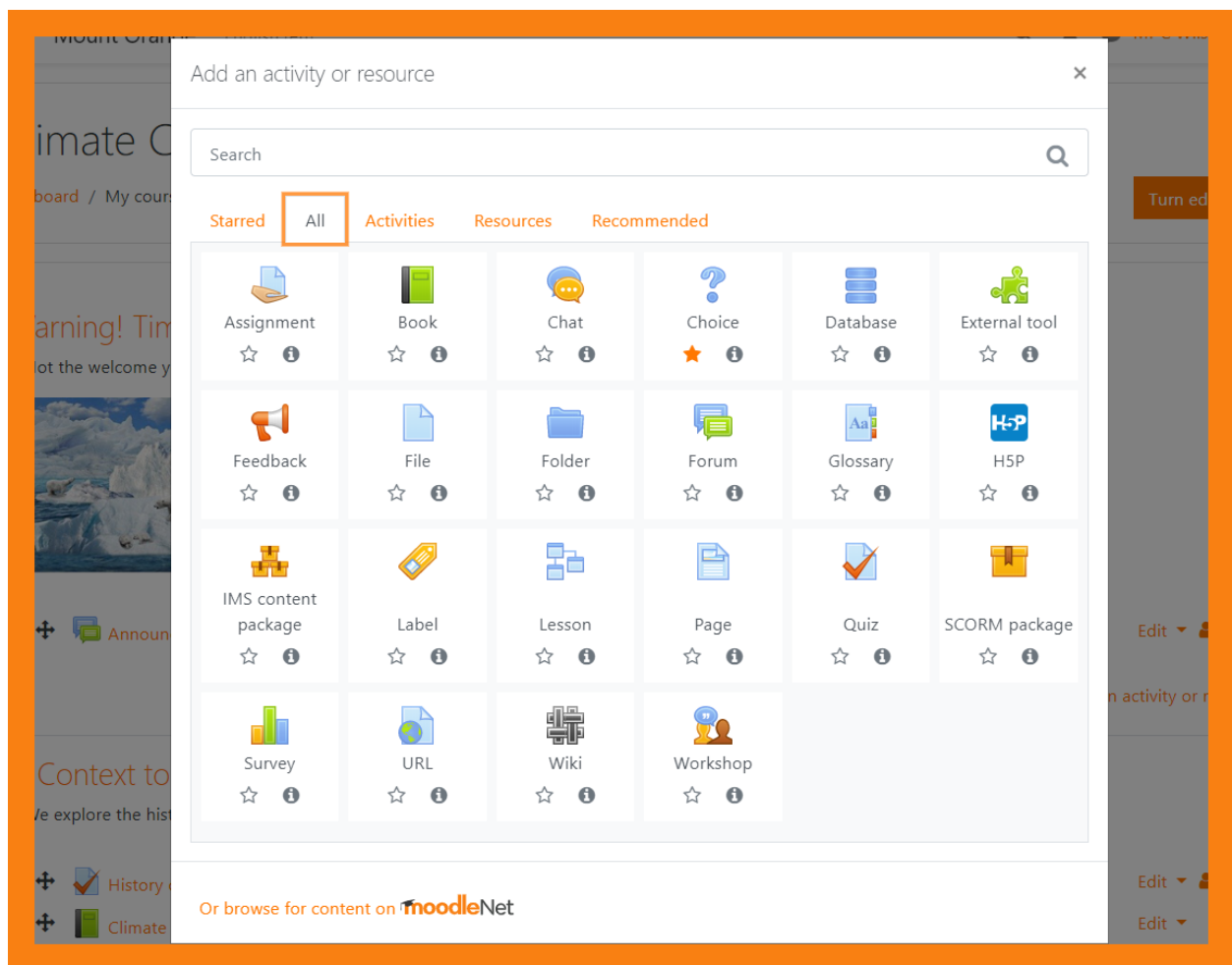


Accessibility Improvements for the Moodle Text Editor

The Moodle text editor has been updated to improve accessibility. This includes when pasting images from your web browser (though this feature may be limited by which browser you use and your current browser version). There is also a clearer focus on selected links within the text editor.

Updated Activity Chooser

When you add an activity or resource to your Moodle course page the pop-up to choose the type of activity to be added will be changed. Below is an example of what this new activity chooser looks like:



With the activity chooser you will be able to star frequently used activities for quick access. Information about each activity is available by pressing the i button below the activity icon.

Whole Forum Grading

Instructors who use discussion forums as a graded activity can now set up whole forum grading. This will add a grade users button to the forum page:
