	Copy of student's transcript that clearly shows student's unweighted GPA.
	Counselor Statement - Three copies, if included.
	One 2026 Teacher Recommendation Form - one completed 2026 Teacher Recommendation Form from a teacher that taught the student in the 9 th , 10 th or 11 th grade in an academic subject: (e.g., English; social studies or history; world languages; the sciences; or mathematics). both student and recommender name boxes complete subject line and year taught are marked/completed verify one number is checked for each quality listed. ensure recommender responses are included for required questions
	One 2026 Community Recommendation Form - one completed 2026 Community Recommendation Form from a community member who is not a member of the student's family, or of any GSP Selection Committee and who can provide a perspective of the applicant as a community member rather than as a student. Student name and recommender name/position boxes are complete verify one number is checked for each quality listed. ensure recommender responses are included for required questions
