Ready for the Future.

In 2021 we redesigned our program to be flexible and accessible for our own graduate students and ready to meet the needs of the children and youth they will be serving in schools. Updates in our format and increased coverage of topics like social emotional learning, diversity, trauma, and behavior analysis prepare graduates to meet the current challenges facing students and their families.

What does MSU Moorhead's School Psych program look like?

- 1. NASP-approved two degree program—Master's & Specialist's degree (the typical standard for licensure)
- 2. Tracks: <u>2-year + internship</u> (10-12 credits per semester and 100 hours of practicum) or <u>3-year + internship</u> (6-8 credits per semester and practicum)
- 3. Learning Formats: We have primarily in person (on campus) students but we also have some remote online students. Online student slots are intended for students working with a school district for practicum who cannot move to the Moorhead area to attend classes on campus. Remote and in person students attend classes synchronously (at the same time) using technology so all students can see and hear each other. We also have 3-5 summer class days on campus for all students (Remote and In-person students) together.
- 4. Courses begin <u>Summer</u> (Psy 620 Measurement & Psy 575 Applied Behavior Analysis). During school year-classes will run 1-2 afternoons/evenings (synchronous) per week
- 5. Cohorts are 12-16 candidates (4 -6 grow your own online and 10-12 in person)
