• Trauma-Informed Schools

RENEW

• RENEW (Rehabilitation for Empowerment, Natural Supports, Education, and Work) is a structured school-to-career transition planning and individualized wraparound process for youth with emotional and behavioral challenges both with and without IEPs. The model focuses on supporting each youth to design and pursue a plan for the transition from school to adult life. RENEW has been the focus of many qualitative and correlative studies. For nearly two decades, RENEW has shown strong evidence that it is a promising practice for improving outcomes with transition age youth experiencing emotional and/or behavioral challenges. RENEW has substantially increased high school completion, employment, and post-secondary education participation rates among our most vulnerable youth.

Unrestricted Social Work Services

 These services can be requested at a per diem rate to assist with regular education mental/behavioral health needs and programming. This service can be requested per day to help districts meet the challenges of post-pandemic transition.
