

5-Day Devotion: Unity before Power

Theme: Embracing Unity in Transition to Find Power

Day 1: Understanding Transition

Scripture: Acts 1:12-14

Reflection: Just like the disciples after Jesus's departure, we often find ourselves in periods of transition. These times can be filled with uncertainty and fear. It's essential to recognize that transitions are opportunities for growth. The disciples gathered in the upper room, not just out of fear, but to prepare themselves for the mission ahead.

Scripture: Colossians 3:13

Reflection: To remain unified, we must actively participate in our community. This includes showing up, supporting each other, and practicing the “one another” commands like love and forgiveness. When we do this, we become a powerful force for God.

Application: Attend a church meeting or Bible study this week. Make a commitment to be present and engaged.

Prayer: Ask God to show you how to contribute actively to your church community and to help you remain accountable to your commitments.

Day 4: The Necessity of Prayer

Scripture: Acts 1:14

Reflection: The disciples’ first act after Jesus's ascension was to pray together. Prayer is the glue that holds us together in unity. It transforms our hearts and aligns our motives with God’s purpose.

Application: Set aside time today to pray for your church community. Consider organizing a prayer group to regularly intercede for one another.

Prayer: Pray for the spirit of prayer to fill your church, uniting everyone in purpose and mission.

Day 5: Waiting with Anticipation

Scripture: Acts 1:4-8

Reflection: Waiting is often the hardest part, but it's essential for preparing us for what God has planned. The disciples had to wait for the Holy Spirit, which empowered them for their mission. Trusting God's timing is crucial.

Application: Reflect on areas of your life where you need to practice waiting. How can you cultivate patience and faith during this time?

Prayer: Ask God to help you wait with a heart full of anticipation for the blessings and power He has promised.
