What does a "founder's journey" look like at 4.0?

4.0 is the largest and earliest investor in education today. Our process includes evaluation and feedback for founders on their own development as leaders and on the design and impact of the ventures they dream of creating. We collect data at every stage along this continuum, on both the leader's own development and on their pop-ups and pilots.

Essentials Fellows get coaching from entrepreneurs, up to a \$1K grant, and a community of peers pushing them to run their first test (e.g. Saturday event). By the end of Essentials, fellows will have feedback from users and the skills needed to continue refining their idea. Pilots are extended tests led by Tiny Fellows that serve ten or more users for a week to a semester (e.g. afterschool program or summer camp). Fellows keep their day jobs and receive up to a \$10K grant from 4.0. After Tiny, the most promising alumni are connected with downstream partners who help take their ideas to scale as new schools, nonprofits or companies.
