103 - (10) Ashley Liff (3-16)

vs. **(10) Kevin Antero (29-11) D2, R4**

- Antero in quickly on a single and finishes to go on top 2-0. He works a quick tilt to increase it to 5-0 before locking up a cradle for the fall.
 - **2008 6, 2010 0**

112 - (12) Kevin Churchill (41-4) D2, R2, S3 vs. (9) Tyler Samuel-Siegel (5-8)

- 2008 waits to see who 2010 sends out and decides to move their lineup. Churchill makes quick work of Samuel-Siegel as he hits a single to a half for the fall!
 - **2010 6, 2008 6**

119 - (12) Kevin Antero (20-12) D3, R7/8 vs. (10) Kevin Churchill (32-5) D3, R4

- Good matchup here as both teams look to get the upper hand! Antero tries to take a single but Churchill counters and they are out of bounds. Churchill tries a slide by but Antero counters...it's as if they know what to expect from each other. (they were drill partners for 4 years!) Churchill tries another shot but time runs out. Antero takes bottom and Churchill is riding tough. He gets the legs in but Antero is able to get out of bounds. Off the restart, Churchill is able to lock up a ball and chain and tilts Antero for 3 backs. 3-0 after 2 and Churchill takes bottom. He is out and they are hand fighting and moving as if it is a dance. So fluid and graceful by both wrestlers. Unfortunately that is not helping Antero, as he needs to score. Churchill attempts another shot but it's another stalemate! Antero tries a desperation dump but no go!! 4-0 Churchill!

- **2008 9, 2010 6**

125 - (9) Josh Sibbles (3-15) vs. (9) Jon Risk (24-10) D4

- 2010 looks like they are bouncing now as well and sends out Sibbles, whose record is deceiving as he is really a 119lber who has wrestled between 125 and 130 this season. Risk looking to add to 2008's lead. Risk scores quickly with a slick duck under. He works for a turn and is able to get 2 backs on a tilt. Sibbles working hard to score but fall into a far side cradle. Risk is trying to position for the fall..and gets it!!

- **2008 15, 2010 6**

130 - (10) Steven Churchill (17-6) D2 vs. (12) Joe Daniele (15-18)

- Churchill out fast as 2010 needs some points. He works a Russian to a snap down and is able to get a front headlock. He is circling behind but reverses course and hits a gator roll....and gets the fall!

- **2008 15, 2010 12**

135 - (10) Jake Connelly (21-15) D3, R7/8 vs. (10) Adam Armstrong (8-4)

- 2008 decides to bump the lineup again after Connelly takes the mat! Armstrong has wrestled tough but Connelly is out for blood! Connelly scores the first TD, cuts Armstrong, and scores again. 4-1 after 1. Connelly defers and Armstrong takes top...looking for a cradle. Connelly catches the arm and is able to schradler out for an escape. 5-1. Connelly scores another TD and its 7-1 after 2. Connelly takes neutral to start the 3rd and gets another TD...7-1 and he is looking for a major decision. He cuts Armstrong again but Armstrong is able to defend the next shot. Connelly getting aggressive but Armstrong holds his ground, falling 7-1.

- **2010 15, 2008 15**

140 - (11) Jon Risk (26-9) D3, R7/8 vs. (11) Kyle Huber (28-11) D2, R5/6

- Big matchup here as both were regional qualifiers during their Jr. years. Huber strikes first for a TD with about :45 left off a reattack when Risk attempts a drag to a double. 2-0 Huber after 1. Risk defers and Huber takes bottom...Risk right to a bar and a half but he goes tilt instead and gets a 2 count...2-2. Huber to his feet but a solid mat return by Risk and a solid ride ends the period at 2! Risk takes bottom and he goes quad pod and tries to step over Huber, who elevates his hips and almost puts Risk to his back. Risk bellies out and Huber is able to slip his leg in and ride tough before they wind up out of bounds. :18 left in the period. Risk to his feet and it's Huber's turn to mat return. Risk attempts a granby on the way down but Huber follows and is able to lock up a cheap tilt on the way through and he gets 2 flags. Risk trying desperately to get to his feet or to score a reversal. He almost has 2 but Huber pushes him away as time expires and holds on for the 4-3 win!

- **2008 18, 2010 15**

145 - (12) Adam Armstrong (14-16) D3 vs. (11) Kyle Molitoris (11-22)

- Neither wrestler pushes the action in the opening period as they both prefer to be on the mat. 0-0 after 1. Armstrong takes bottom and is able to break free after Molitoris almost locks up a cradle. No more action in the period...1-0 Armstrong, Molitoris takes bottom. He hits a knee slide off the whistle and Armstrong counters by switching sides and chopping. He locks up a cross-face but can't get the cradle..He tries a pumphandle but Molitoris counters by posting his leg...Armstrong jumps to the cradle as Coach Bollette yells "It only works!" as he takes Molitoris to his back. Armstrong gets 3 backs and almost gets the fall before Molitoris is able to punch through to his belly. Armstrong rides tough the rest of the way and holds on for the 4-0 win.
 - **2010 18, 2008 18**

152 - (11) Kevin Kitchel (6-14) vs. (10) Casey Campbell (22-13) D3

- Campbell looking to regain the lead for 2008 and he scores first with a slick drag to a near single leg for the TD. He gets right to work and locks up a cross-face to a pumphandle and has Kitchel in trouble. Kitchel fighting tough but Campbell too strong and gets the fall!
 - **2008 24, 2010 18**

160 - (12) Casey Campbell (24-4) D3 vs. (12) Austin Alpaugh) D1, R1, S7

- Campbell has had a fine career for the Braves but has his hands full with Alpaugh, a 2x District Champion, Region Champion and State Medalist. Alpaugh goes outside single to score the 1st TD of the bout. He cuts Campbell and hits a slick dump for 5 and a 7-1 lead after 1. Campbell defers and Alpaugh takes bottom...Campbell riding tough and Alpaugh can only muster a late escape to go up 8-1 after 2. Campbell takes bottom and Alpaugh works in a nice tilt for 3 backs and comes up with the legs in and gets another turn to go up 14-1. Campbell working tough to finish the bout but Alpaugh is able to work a reverse merkle for 2 more backs and the TF with :32 seconds left.
 - **2008 29, 2010 18**

171 - (12) Teddy Sibblies (8-17) vs. (9) Stephen Mihail (28-8) D2

- Mihail out fast vs. Sibblies, the hero of the 2010 Sectional title match! Mihail scores 3 TD's in period 1 to go up 6-2. Mihail defers and Sibblies goes bottom. Mihail lets him go and scores another TD and a turn to go up 11-3 after 2. Mihail takes bottom and is able to get a reversal and two more TD's enroute to a very workmanlike 17-5 win!
 - **2008 33, 2010 18**

189 - (11) Stephen Mihail (25-6) D2, R5/6 vs. (12) Ralph Carratura (16-19) D4

- Mihail on the mat again but looks pretty fresh considering he just wrestled. This match is almost a carbon copy of the 171lb match. Mihail scores 3 TD's in period 1 to go up 6-2. Carratura defers and Mihail goes bottom and is able to get a reversal and two more TD's

to go up 12-4 after 2. Carratura takes top looking for a cradle but Mihail gets an escape and a TD and ride out to win 15-4.

- **2008 33, 2010 22**

215 - (11) Victor Ramos (18-9) D3, R7/8 vs. (9) Victor Ramos (7-16)

- 9th grade Ramos is no match for 11th grade Ramos, as the latter is able to lock up an over/under and hit a lateral drop for a quick fall. It's as if they had this planned all along!

- **2008 33, 2010 28**

285 - (11) Evan Chrustic (21-13) D1, R7/8 vs. (11) Ed Mattice (39-2) D1, R1

- Chrustic needs a pin to win the dual for 2010, a tall order vs. Region champ Mattice. Chrustic comes out swinging as he tries a headlock but Mattice counters and gets a TD. Mattice rides tough with bone series and finishes the period on top. Mattice defers and Chrustic takes neutral (needs the fall so kid is going for broke). Chrustic trying to grab Mattice, who uses Chrustic's aggressiveness to snap and score another TD. 4-0 after 2 Mattice chooses bottom. Chrustic cuts him loose as he feels he has a better shot at the fall from neutral. They tie up and Chrustic locks up another headlock and has Mattice going to his back....but Mattice rolls through and gets the TD and ride out as 2008 pulls off the upset!!! Mattice 7-0.
