

- If you haven't already done so, please consider filling out a lunch application linked <u>here</u>. Having all parents complete this form helps us minimize lunch debt that accumulates throughout the school year. Students have already accumulated over \$400 worth of cafeteria debt in the first week of school!
- Our normal school day begins for students at 8:45 a.m. and ends at 3:45 p.m. Students should not be dropped off before 8:15 a.m. unless arrangements have been made with a teacher. Because we have buses that drop off before 8:15 a.m., students are able to wait in the cafeteria from 7:45 a.m. until 8:15 a.m., when additional supervision arrives on campus. Students should be picked up by 4:15 p.m. unless they are with a teacher or coach.
- The map for car rider pick-up and drop-off is linked <u>here</u>. Please do not pick up or drop off students in other areas of the school. The car rider entrance/line off Gerringer Mill Rd is a one-way street. Please do not pull into the line and turn around to exit onto Gerringer Mill. This causes traffic issues and is a safety hazard.
- Student drivers who want to park on campus must visit the link <u>here</u> to get a
  parking pass. We will announce when parking passes are available for pickup.
- This year, we are offering families the opportunity to purchase optional insurance for their student's Chromebook. The cost of the optional insurance is \$25. This premium is good for one instance of unintentional breakage (lost or intentional damage is not covered) and will help protect you from higher costs. You may elect when to apply your premium. Once used, the family would have the option to replace the optional insurance premium for an additional \$25.
